At our July meeting in Weymouth we had a double bill of speakers. Frances Booth came from her base at the Royal Bournemouth Hospital to talk about a service called 'My Health, My Way' that operates across Dorset to help individuals to regain quality life after some health condition has interfered with 'their normality'. Sometimes there is not actually a <u>medical</u> answer. It may be lack of transport or personal contacts. They say

- Frustration, fatigue, pain and isolation
- Appropriate exercise for maintaining and improving strength, flexibility and endurance

- Appropriate use of medication
- Communicating effectively with family, friends and health professionals
- Nutrition, decision-making and how to evaluate new treatments

Courses take place once a week for 6 weeks, and each session lasts for 2 and a half hours.

- Weymouth Wednesdays, starting 2nd September 2015
- Sherborne Tuesdays, starting 27th October 2015
- Dorchester Wednesdays, starting 28th October 2015
